Erin Alcorn *Lyric soprano and fast-rising opera star*

Praised for her expressive singing, Erin Alcorn is a lyric soprano currently based in Philadelphia. Erin was most recently seen as Adina in *The Elixir of Love* with The Dallas Opera Outreach program, and she will sing as a chorus member in Opera Philadelphia's *Turandot* in 2016. Erin has performed as a soloist for various engagements including the University of North Texas Gala featuring love songs from Broadway.

Tom Baust *Accomplished and versatile baritone singer and pianist*

Accomplished on voice and on the piano, Tom Baust presents entertaining, educational one-man programs unfolding the life and musical legacies of Broadway and film composers, as well as programs with themes of Tin Pan Alley and others. In addition to his one-man shows, his Tom Baust and Friends Concerts can include other performers as well as "4 hands, 1 piano" programs.
